Upcoming events for May / June

Gentlemen,

The 2018 SGA season is underway with our first SGA Play with the Pro event. Matt Workman, Jim Hickman, Rick Rollinson, Scott Pollock posted a score of 128. The second play with the pro event took place yesterday, Thursday, May 3rd. The team of Chris Brumbaugh, Dave Mazo, John Wenhart, and George Wallace took the lead with the score of 123.

We will host this event once a month to give everyone an opportunity to play with your professional staff!

Our first SGA Reverse Shotgun was a huge success with 40 golfers participating in the opening tournament! We added a great "twist" with two closest to the pin contests, one for white tee players and one for black tee golfers. Bob Smith walked away with \$105 for knocking his shot the closest on hole #3 and Kurt Faxon left with \$35 with his close-up on hole #15, nice going Guys.

SGA Cup points for this event are as follows: Overall winner 5 points, 1st place in flight will receive 10 points, 2nd place will receive 5 points, 3rd place will receive 2 points, and all participants will receive 2 points.

The following is information written by Bob Catapano regarding the CASMGA championship and new committee members:

The Capital Area Senior Men's Golf Association (CASMGA) organizes the Interclub events in which the members of the North Ridge Country Club SGA have the opportunity to participate. Participation in the Interclub events are open to all SGA members on a first come - first served basis. The number of North Ridge golfers allowed to participate in each event varies and is set by the CASMGA organizers on the basis of past attendance by our members at each of the other clubs. Each club sends representatives to annual CASMGA meetings. The tradition at North Ridge has been to send two members of the current SGA Board. The more "typical" approach used by other clubs provides more continuity over time - by sending the same representatives year after year. Your present 2018 SGA Board has decided to begin using a hybrid approach. The Board intended to name one member as a "permanent" representative to the CASMGA Board along with one SGA Board member to join him. Your Board has invited (me) Bob Catapano to be the permanent SGA rep to CASMGA and I have agreed to do it so long as future Boards want me to continue doing so. SGA President Scott Atcheson will ride shotgun with Bob as the rep to CASMGA this year.

In addition to the schedule of Interclub events, CASMGA also organizes a one-day season-ending championship event - the CASMGA Championship. Unlike the other Interclub events, the CASMGA Championship is a competition between the twelve clubs that make up the organization. Each club's team score is the sum of their four two-man team net better ball scores. The CASMGA Rules and Regulations are very brief when it comes to who can play in the CASMGA Championship, but they do stipulate that each of the eight players from each club must have played in at least one Interclub event during the calendar year. We will abide by that rule.

How will the eight players who make up the North Ridge team for the CASMGA Championships be chosen? Bob Catapano will chair a selection committee of three (Myself and two others) SGA members to choose the team and put them into four two-man teams. Scott Atcheson and Bob Smith will be on the selection committee in 2018. The mission of the selection committee will be to create a NRCC team to be as competitive as possible. The selection criteria are now under consideration and will be communicated to all SGA Members in the coming weeks. We are all excited with the start to our 2018 SGA schedule and look forward to closing out the season with a great team representing NRCC at the CASMGA Championship in an effort to bring the CASMGA Cup to North Ridge!
